




LUNCH ACCOUNTS

- **GENERAL ACCOUNT**—used for Ala Carte charges (MS/HS cafeteria only); may be used to charge USDA approved Lunch meal
- **MEAL ACCOUNT**—used only for USDA approved lunch meal

Note: It is highly recommended to set-up charge limits to General Accounts

USDA National School Lunch Program

The U.S.D.A. National School Lunch Program (Free and Reduced Lunch Program – on Okinawa) is available to all students on Okinawa who qualify and are attending DoDEA Schools.

Eligibility Application Start Date:
01 July EVERY YEAR

Applications must be submitted/
resubmitted under the following criteria:

1. **Beginning of each school year**
2. If total number of family members currently residing in quarters with sponsor increase or decrease
3. When USDA changes the Income Eligibility Guidelines



HOW TO APPLY

- Fill out the Free/Reduced Lunch Application form
- Provide a copy of the most recent LES/ Pay Stub of all income earners in the household
- Take the application form and LES/Pay Stub to Bldg 99, Free/Reduced Lunch Office for approval/processing or you can email all necessary documents to 18msg.kadenalunchprogram@us.af.mil
- Once approved, set-up/update your lunch account at the Exchange customer service counter (Kadena AB, Camp Foster, Camp Kinser and Camp Courtney)
