For MFH Residents ONLY. Trash from Off-base residences is not permitted at the Kadena recycling center or in Kadena dumpsters. Off-base residents; refer to your housing agency's refuse/recycling guide.

Refuse, bulk waste, and recyclables must be placed in the designated location <u>no later than 08:00 AM</u> on the scheduled day.

Glass										
Whole bottles and jars only. Do not break. Rinse well.										
Metals										
 Empty aluminum and steel cans: Rinse well, remove labels and lids 										
- Metal cookware: Clean and remove all food waste										
 Metal grills: Remove charcoal, food remnants, propane and plastic parts 										
- Lawnmowers or other gas-powered tools: Remove gas and oil										
 Mixed material items (bicycles, gym equipment, metal shelving, etc.): remove fabrics, plastics, and other non-metal 										
Electrical wires including those cut from small appliances Paper

Newspaper, white paper, and clean food boxes such as cereal or soda boxes. Separate shredded from non-shredded paper. Plastics: 1 PET

Styrofoam										
Crumbly Styrofoam only; no packing peanuts.										
Unserviceable Large Appliances										
E.g. Refrigerator, washing machine, dryer, dehumidifiers, freezer (excluding commercial type).										
Used Cooking Oil										
Strain cooking debris from oil, place in original sealed containers or take it to the Recycling Center (Bldg. 871 near Karing										
Kennels Gate 3).										
Yard Waste Bundle branches/sticks with string in bunches no longer than 6' and less than 8" diameter. Bag leaves and grass.										
SPECIAL HANDLING REQUIRED										
Aerosol Containers										
- If empty, puncture and recycle with metal recyclables.										
- If full or partially full, take to Eagle Hardware or to Kadena Environmental Hazardous Waste Storage Area (Bldg. 3623) Automotive Batteries										
Take to Auto Hobby Shop (Bldg. 1436) 966-7355, AAFES auto service station (Bldg. 218), or Kadena Environmental Hazardous										
Waste Storage Area (Bldg. 3623).

SPECIAL HANDLING REQUIRED - Continued

Fluorescent lamps and light ballasts

Take to Eagle Hardware or Kadena Environmental Hazardous Waste Storage Area (Bldg. 3623).

Batteries - NiCad, Lithium and Alkaline

Place tape over terminals and take to Eagle Hardware or Kadena Environmental Hazardous Waste Storage Area (Bldg. 3623).

Hazardous Materials (including empty containers)

Mercury containing devices, fire extinguishers, paints, solvents, adhesives, etc. Take to Environmental Hazardous Waste Storage Area (Bldg. 3623).

Household Hazardous Wastes

Cleaning products for your home (bleach, cleaning alcohol, detergents, etc.). Take to Eagle Hardware or Environmental Hazardous Waste Storage Area (Bldg. 3623).

Medical Waste / Excess Medication

Please contact the medical facilities where you received your medical supplies or prescription. Contact medical waste coordinator at the Kadena Medical Clinic at DSN 630-4166 or USNH Okinawa at cell 098-971-9355 for more information.

Propane Cylinders (Large – for Gas Grills)

Contact AAFES customer service 966-7482 or take it to AAFES Service Station (Bldg. 218).

Propane Cylinders (Small - Camping Style)

- If empty, puncture or make a hole and recycle with other metal recyclables
- If full or partially full, take to Kadena Environmental Hazardous Waste Storage Area (Bldg. 3623) 634-2600

Toner

Place no more than 6 cartridges in a clear bag and dispose of with refuse/trash.

Broken Glass

Separate from the refuse/trash, Wrap in paper before disposal.

- 4) Consider donating or selling serviceable appliances, books, cookware, clothing or other items
 - a. Unwanted books and useable household items can often be donated to the Kadena Thrift Shop in Building 859 or the USMC Thrift Shop at Camp Foster Bldg. 5691 (645-6025).
 - b. Manga Souko, Second Street, and Hard off/book off are second hand re-sale chains with multiple locations.
 - c. Oki Hands Oki Hearts, and Help Oki are charity organizations that take certain items.
 - d. Flea Markets, Facebook Marketplace, and Bookoo are options for selling or giving away unwanted, working items in good condition
