## MEMORANDUM FOR PET OWNERS IN OKINAWA FAMILY HOUSING

SUBJECT: Acknowledgement of Understanding and Agreement for Pets in Military Family Housing

- 1. Okinawa Family Housing has a two-pet limit; two cats, two dogs or one of each. This does not include small, caged animals such as fish or hamsters. Residents are not permitted to board exotic animals such as, but not limited to, reptiles, rodents (other than hamsters and guinea pigs), ferrets, hedgehogs, skunks, rats, raccoons, squirrels, potbellied pigs, monkeys, arachnids, or any farm animal *IAW AFI32-6000*. Families in excess of two pets must route an Exception to Policy (ETP) through their chain of command.
- 2. Residents may not board dogs of any breed (including a mixed breed) that are deemed "aggressive" or "potentially aggressive", unless the dog is a certified military working dog that is being boarded by its handler/trainer with written approval of the Defense Force Commander or approval is obtained by the Commander in writing. (T-0) For purposes of this policy, "aggressive" or "potentially aggressive" breeds of dogs are defined as a Pit Bull (American Staffordshire Bull Terrier or English Staffordshire Bull Terrier), Rottweiler, Doberman Pinscher, Chow, and wolf hybrids. Prohibition also extends to other breeds of dogs or individual dogs that demonstrate or are known to demonstrate a propensity for dominant or aggressive behavior, as specified in *AFI32-6000 Sec 2.21.1*.
  - a. Residents with "aggressive" or "potentially aggressive" breeds will be required to live on-base.
- 3. \_\_\_\_ I currently do not have any pets. I understand it is my responsibility to immediately notify the Military Housing Office (MHO) of breed and type of animal if I acquire an animal after arriving on Okinawa. I also understand and acknowledge the below expectations if I choose to get a pet in the future.
- 4. \_\_\_\_ I understand I have elected to have a pet in Military Family Housing (MFH) and acknowledge the responsibilities of having a pet in Okinawa, to include the *Okinawa Family Housing Brochure* and the *Joint Service Pet Policy for All Military Family Housing (MFH) on Okinawa*.
