Colonel Jason P. Kane serves as the 18th Mission Support Group Commander, Kadena Air Base, Japan. He commands the largest Mission Support Group in Pacific Air Forces and oversees a \$7 million budget, \$450 million of assets, and 3,400 military and civilian members comprising six squadrons. The group is also responsible for the operation of the Okuma Recreation Facility on Okinawa and the Bellows Air Force Station Recreation Facility in Hawaii.

Colonel Kane entered the Air Force in 2000 as a distinguished graduate of the University of Florida's Air Force Reserve Officer Training Corps. He has served in a variety of positions at the squadron, group, MAJCOM staff, Air Staff, Joint Task Force, and Combatant Command levels. Colonel Kane has deployed four times to various locations supporting Operations Enduring Freedom, Iraqi Freedom, and Inherent Resolve, as well as Joint Task Force Georgian Sustainment and Stability Operations Program II.
