18TH WING COMMANDER HAS DIRECTED

TCCOR 4

DESTRUCTIVE WINDS ARE POSSIBLE WITHIN 72 HOURS

ACTIONS

- Monitor AFN Radio (648 AM & 89.1 FM) and the Kadena Connect App for weather updates and TCCOR changes
- Inventory/replenish emergency supplies like non-perishable food, water, sand bags, flashlights, batteries, etc.
- Prepare cell phones to receive emergency notifications

TCCOR 3

DESTRUCTIVE WINDS ARE POSSIBLE WITHIN 48 HOURS

ACTIONS

ALL PERSONNEL:

- Secure ALL outdoor items
- Fill vehicle and grill gas tanks
- Keep important documents safe/accessible
- Clean debris from gutters, storm drains, sidewalks & ditches

FACILITY MANAGERS:

- Lock unused exterior doors/windows
- Ensure access to wet vacuum
- Check generator fuel levels
- Begin securing all outside items
- Remove dead tree branches if possible

DESTRUCTIVE WINDS ARE ANTICIPATED WITHIN 24 HOURS

ACTIONS

ALL PERSONNEL:

- Ensure outside items are secured
- Sandbag door sills
- Secure curbside trash & trash bin area
(Trash pick-up suspended)

FACILITY MANAGERS:

- Secure trash bin area
(Trash pick-up suspended)
- Ensure all loose items in your vicinity
are secured or brought indoors
- Sandbag door sills
- Move electronics off the floor and
cover if not in use

18TH WING COMMANDER HAS DIRECTED

TCCOR 1

DESTRUCTIVE WINDS ARE ANTICIPATED WITHIN 12 HOURS

ACTIONS

ALL PERSONNEL:

- Move vehicles to higher ground if you live in low-lying area
- Keep children at home (Students released from DoDEA Schools)
- Move items away from windows
- Turn fridge/freezer to MAX setting
- Fill tubs with water for flushing toilets

FACILITY MANAGERS:

- Bag all computers and sensitive electronics near windows
- Double check facility exterior and surrounding area
- Secure all facilities not in use

- Secure facility and return to place of residence if non-mission essential
